ac.care has exciting opportunities for dedicated people to join our Therapeutic Strength Based Care (TSBC) program. Staff will be employed on a casual basis but will have the opportunity to apply for permanent part-time lines as they become available.

About you:

- You hold a tertiary qualification relevant to the role;
OR
you hold or are currently studying a Certificate 4 (or above) in either Child, Youth and Family Intervention or Community Services;
OR
If successful, you are willing to commence and actively study one of the above qualifications upon commencement in the role
- You hold, or are willing to obtain prior to commencement a DCSI Child-Related Employment Screening, a Child Safe Environment Certificate and a Provide First Aid certificate (at ac.care's expense)
- You have a passion for making a difference in the lives of children and young people and are eager to learn the latest techniques in therapeutic care.
- You are available to work a minimum of three shifts per week
- You hold a full Driver's Licence.

ac.care is offering:

- competitive salary with shift loadings
- ac.care vehicles provided for transporting clients
- training to work within a therapeutic model of care which incorporates Therapeutic Crisis Intervention and trauma-informed, intentional, client-centred practice.
- ongoing training in regular practice forums with a clinical psychologist where you will learn new techniques to therapeutically respond to individuals with complex needs.
- ongoing coaching and mentoring from your line manager and other experienced staff
- staff numbers per shift based on individual assessment of client needs (usually 2 staff/4 clients)

What will I do as a Therapeutic Support Worker?

You will work as part of a dedicated team providing quality around the clock care in a home-based environment to children and young people who have been placed under the Guardianship of the Minister, building healthy, supportive relationships, and role-modelling appropriate behaviours.

The following conditions also apply:

- Over 21 years of age
- Have a right to live and work in Australia
- Have a current Driver's License with full provisions and willingness to drive in the course of the role
- Basic computer literacy
- Willing to work a 24/7 roster with day, afternoon and active and passive (sleeping) night shifts
